
HOW TO MAKE IRS TAX PAYMENTS ONLINE


Go to www.IRS.gov/payments where you will have several options:

NOTE: ALWAYS use the name and address of the PRIMARY (first listed) taxpayer on the return for making payments.

Unless you already have an account (a good idea if you owe taxes regularly or need to make ES payments) I recommend the Pay now option



the PayUSATax option has both a 1040 and a 941 Series (if you owe payroll tax) -



Choose the appropriate option for Business or Personal payments:



Input this information: Be sure you select the Correct FORM, TAX YEAR, TAX TYPE, QUARTER (if applicable):


